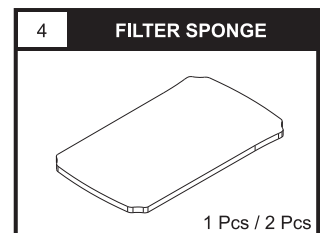
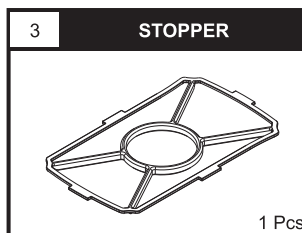
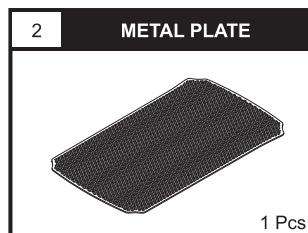
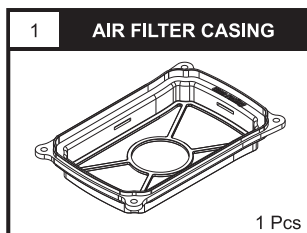
1 AIR FILTER DUAL KIT SERIES (DUAL LAYER FILTER)



2 AIR FILTER KIT SERIES (SINGLE LAYER FILTER)

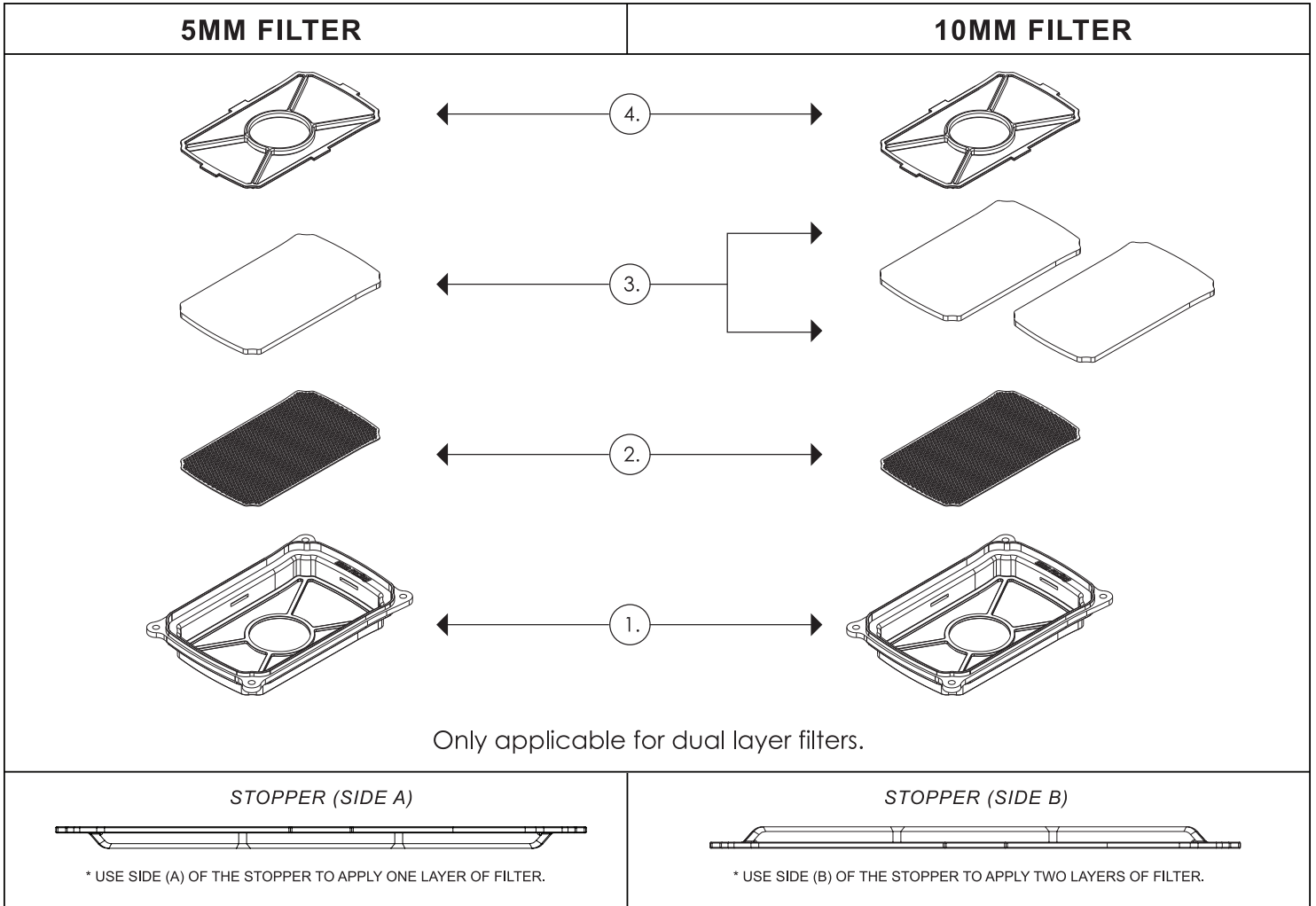


3 PARTS BREAKDOWN

Air filters for the NMAX, BELANG, and R15 models do not require you to flip the stopper. There are two slots available to fit either one or two filter sponges.

1. It is recommended that first-time maintenance be performed at 500 km and then every 2,000 km thereafter.
2. The sponge filters are washable. Wash with clean water or with soap.
3. Washed filters should be air dried properly before being reinstalled back onto the motorcycle.
4. Seek professional help if you are experiencing difficulties.
